- You must be registered for at least 3 semester hours in the semester in which you submit your applied project for examination. You must also be registered for at least 3 semester hours in the semester in which you plan to graduate.
- You must register your intent to present your applied project by the end of the third week of the semester with the Department Secretary in Aderhold Room 604.
- You must submit your completed applied project for departmental review no later than the end of the eighth week of the semester.
- Your applied project presentation may be scheduled to take place no less than two weeks after the completed written report has been submitted to your major advisor, and up to the date of the last class of the semester.
