Notes and reminders (see Graduate Bulletin for more information)

- **Residency requirement:** At least two consecutive semesters of full-time work including enrollment of a minimum of 30 hours of consecutive course work on the program of study.
- **Advisor and committee** identified by the end of the first year of full-time study; at least 3 members must include departmental faculty.
- **Program of Study** must be filed at end of the first year of study.
- **Admission to candidacy** requires passing written and oral comprehensive examination and submitting an approved dissertation prospectus; time limit is 6 years.
- Candidate must be admitted to candidacy at least two semesters before the date of graduation; time limit to complete degree once admitted to candidacy is 5 years.
- You must **apply for graduation** no later than Friday of the first full week of classes two semesters prior to the anticipated graduation date.
- Students must be registered for a minimum of three credit hours the semester in which they complete all degree requirements.
